Woodwork & safety

- Safety glasses should be worn at all times
- Ensure all children are given proper instruction on the correct use of all tools
- A good sturdy workbench with a vice is essential
- Sawing should be monitored 1:1
- Check wood for splinters
- Ensure all nails and screws are picked up from the floor afterwards – a large magnet can work a treat for this – and there will be no shortage of volunteers to use it!
